

Derived Variables – Care Receiving 1/Formal Care (CR1) & Care Receiving 2/Informal Care (CR2)

(Tracking and Comprehensive Assessments)

There is 1 derived variable (DV) in the Care Receiving 1/Formal Care (CR1) module: a flag for receiving formal home care services in the last 12 months. There are 3 derived variables (DVs) in the Care Receiving 2/Informal Care (CR2) module: a flag for receiving informal home care services in the last 12 months, a variable indicating the types of help received in the last 12 months, and the relationship of the main caregiver to the respondent. These DVs are created for participants in both the Tracking and Comprehensive assessments. For simplicity, we describe them here for the Tracking assessment, however, the process of creating the DVs for the Comprehensive assessment is identical. Distinguishing the two are the variable name endings; all variable names in the Tracking assessment end in 'TRM' and in the Comprehensive assessment is named CR1_FRHC_TRM in the Tracking assessment is named CR1_FRHC_COM in the Comprehensive assessment.

1) Flag for Receiving Formal Home Care Services (In the Last 12 Months)

Derived Variable Name: CR1 FRHC TRM

Description: This flag variable indicates whether the respondent received short-term or long-term professional assistance at home during the past 12 months, because of a health condition or limitation that affects the respondent's daily life.

This DV is similar to the variable "CR1FRHC" in Statistics Canada's Canadian Community Health Survey (CCHS) – Healthy Aging.

2) Flag for Receiving Informal Home Care Services (In the Last 12 Months)

Derived Variable Name: CR2_FRHC_TRM

Description: This flag variable indicates whether the respondent received short-term or long-term home care provided by family, friends or neighbours (informal home care) during the past 12 months, because of a health condition or limitation that affects the respondent's daily life.

This DV is similar to the variable "CR2FRHC" in Statistics Canada's Canadian Community Health Survey (CCHS) – Healthy Aging.

3) Receipt of Formal or Informal Home Care (In the Last 12 Months)

Derived Variable Name: CR2_DTHC_TRM

Description: This variable indicates the *type* of home care received by the respondent (formal home care only, informal home care only or both formal and informal home care) during the past 12 months. It uses data from both the CR1 and CR2 modules and is included in the CR2 module.

This DV is similar to the variable "CR2DTHC" in Statistics Canada's Canadian Community Health Survey (CCHS) – Healthy Aging.

4) Relationship of Main Caregiver

Derived Variable Name: CR2_DRMC_TRM

Description: This variable describes the relationship of the main provider of assistance to the respondent over the past 12 months, for the main source of informal assistance (e.g. meal preparation and delivery). This variable was derived by combining the possible values of two characteristics of the main caregiver: sex (CR2_GNDR_TRM) and relation to the respondent (CR2_RELN_TRM). It only applies to those participants who received informal home care over the past 12 months.

This DV is similar to the variable "CR2DRMC" in Statistics Canada's Canadian Community Health Survey (CCHS) – Healthy Aging.

Based on: CR2_FRHC_TRM, CR2_GNDR_TRM, CR2_RELN_TRM

Note: Extra categories were added to CR2_RELN_TRM based on the open text specifications of "other".
